

FOX RUN 2006 POOL SEASON

POOL SEASON IS COMING SOON!!! The Fox Run Pool is scheduled for opening on Saturday, May 27, 2006. Please review the information in the packet and follow each step to ensure proper and prompt handling.

To register for the pool, please follow these steps:

1. The 2006 assessment and all prior year assessments must be paid in full. You must be a member in good standing to register for the pool.
2. Complete the enclosed form.
3. Mail the enclosed form to CONSOLIDATED MANAGEMENT SERVICES, 2204 TIMBERLOCH PLACE, SUITE 245, THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS 77380, or Drop off the enclosed form to the Pool House during Pool Hours.
4. Photos of each family member will be taken at the pool then a Fox Run Pool I.D. card will be issued.
5. Fox Run Pool I.D. cards will be issued at a cost of \$5.00 each.
6. You may bring a guest to the pool provided that they are not resident of the Subdivision. Guest will be assessed a fee of \$2.00 per day. Depending upon the number of swimmers, guest may be limited to two guest per family. The number of Guest permitted will be at the sole discretion of the lifeguards.

A LATE REGISTRATION FEE OF \$5.00 WILL BE CHARGED AFTER 6/15/06

NOTE: The pool is closed on Mondays. The pool will be open on Memorial Day and Labor Day. The pool will be closed the Tuesday after Memorial Day.

Fox Run Pool – General Pool Rules

1. No one will be admitted without their Fox Run Pool I.D. card.
2. Children ages 7 and under must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. Children ages 8-10 must pass a swim test to remain at the pool without supervision. Children ages 11 and older do not need to be supervised by an adult.
3. Members who have guests must sign them in and be responsible for them at all times. Guest passes may be purchased at a cost \$2 per guest per day.
4. Proper swimming attire is required to enter the pool. No jeans or cloth shirts. White T-Shirts only.
5. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of the baby pool.
6. All babies must wear swim diapers while in the pool area.
7. Parents with children in the baby pool must be inside the fence and within 15 feet of the baby pool at all times.
8. The use of cocoa butter, baby oil and other heavy suntan oils causes damage to the pool filtration system. It is required that these lotions not be permitted in the pool area.
9. No glass containers or alcoholic beverages will be allowed inside the pool area.
10. Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics are not allowed within the pool area and will be asked to leave.
11. Floating items will be allowed at the pool at the lifeguard's discretion depending on the number of swimmers.
12. Absolutely no foul or abusive language will be permitted.
13. No pets are permitted on the pool premises.
14. No loud or offensive music will be allowed in the pool area.
15. No running or rough play will be allowed.
16. No swimming after designated hours, unless special arrangements have been made through the Board of Directors or the Management Company. Persons found in violation of this rule will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

17. Riding any wheeled vehicles in the pool area is prohibited. The only exception is for those with physical impairments. All bicycles must be kept on the furnished bike rack.
18. Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the pool area.
19. Only (1) person is allowed on the diving board at a time. All diving or jumping must be done straight off the end of the board. Divers must wait until the entire deep end is clear before diving. Divers must exit the diving area as quickly as possible.
20. No diving in the shallow end of the pool (less than 5 feet).
21. Lifeguards on duty have complete authority at all times under the supervision of the Pool Manager. Management reserves the right to deny any patron access should the rules and policies set forth by the Board of Directors not be followed.
22. Tuesday and Thursday from 10AM to 1PM pool use is restricted to toddlers and seniors. A toddler is defined as a child age 6 and under. A senior is defined as an adult age 50 or older.
23. Other rules may be created or amended and enforced at any time in the interest of patron safety.
